General Notes & Symbols

Time Symbols

- a** Arrival time
 - d** Departure time
 - p** Time from previous night
 - s** Stops to set down passengers only
 - u** Stops to pick up passengers only
 - x** Stops on request only. To alight, please inform the guard on the train. To board, display an appropriate hand signal to the driver, or press the 'request train' button, if there is one on the platform.
- A highlighted header signifies that the train does not run for the full duration of the timetable.

Days of Operations

Days of operation codes are made up of two portions. The first is the day (or days) relevant to the train, and the second is whether the train runs, or doesn't run on these days.

M Monday	O Only
T Tuesday	X Excepted
W Wednesday	
Th Thursday	Examples
F Friday	MO - Monday Only
S Saturday	ThX - Thursdays Excepted (does not run on Thursdays)
Su Sunday	TWO - Tuesdays and Wednesdays Only
BH Bank Holidays	BHX - Bank Holidays Excepted (Does not run on Bank Holidays)

Headcodes

A headcode is a 4 character reporting code assigned to each train and used by various industry departments.

The **first** character is a number that represents a train's category (shown below).

The **second** character is a letter, and represents the route a train takes.

The **third & fourth** characters are incremental digits that identify a specific train.

- 1** Class 1 trains usually represent express services
- 2** Class 2 trains usually represent local stopping services
- 3** Class 3 trains usually represent a higher priority Empty Coaching Stock (ECS) move
- 5** Class 5 trains usually represent standard & lower-priority ECS moves






Other classes of train represent freight and some departmental services



Reservation & Accommodation Symbols

-  Seat reservations are compulsory on this train..
-  Seat reservations are recommended on this train..
-  Seat reservations available. This symbol is also used for 'counted places' (a system used for advanced purchase ticket quotas) and does not necessarily denote the ability to reserve a seat.
-  First class accommodation is conveyed on this train.
-  Sleeping berths and first class seating are available on this train. Reservations compulsory.

Catering Symbols

These symbols relate to catering facilities available on board trains. These may be available for the whole, or only part of the journey.

-  An at seat trolley service of hot and cold refreshments is available.
-  A buffet service, including hot and cold snacks and drinks is provided.
-  An at table Restaurant service for First Class ticket holders, and Standard Class ticket holders if accommodation is available. A buffet service is also available.
-  Complimentary restaurant or full meal service for First Class ticket holders, with a buffet service available to all passengers.
-  A service of hot light meals to order, as well as a buffet service of hot and cold refreshments.

Timing Load / Traction

Most journeys contain timing load and traction details. These records are used for scheduling purposes and help to differentiate between slower & faster trains. As a result, shown traction is not guaranteed to operate and is sometimes erroneous, but can give an overview of what to expect.
